GRADUATING THIS SUMMER?

To register for the Diploma Application/Graduation, log into Cardinal Station and follow the prompts on the menu (see the Fall Calendar for deadline (usually the last Friday in September). Please note: there is a commencement fee associated with the diploma application that must be reconciled before receiving your diploma: **Cardinal Students → Self Services → Graduation → Apply for Graduation**

You'll receive your diplomas after the October 31st graduation date **IF** you deposit in your thesis on time—usually by the 3rd Monday in September (see fall's schedule). Otherwise, you will be a FALL graduate (January 9th).
